**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND
CHAPTER 10 ENTITLED, "PARADES, PROCESSIONS AND MARCHES,"
OF TITLE 11 ENTITLED, "TRAFFIC," OF THE VILLAGE CODE
OF THE VILLAGE OF GLENDALE HEIGHTS, ILLINOIS**

WHEREAS, the Village of Glendale Heights deems it necessary and desirable to amend Title 11, Chapter 10 of the Glendale Heights Village Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Glendale Heights, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1: That Section 11-10-1 entitled, "Application," of Chapter 10 entitled, "Parades, Processions and Marches," of Title 11 entitled, "Traffic," of the Glendale Heights Village Code is amended as follows:

By amending the last sentence of the first paragraph to read as follows:

"Each application shall contain the following information and be accompanied by a non-refundable application fee of \$35.00 which may be waived by the Village Clerk upon request of the applicant for good cause:"

Section 2: That Section 11-10-1 entitled, "Application," of Chapter 10 entitled, "Parades, Processions and Marches," of Title 11 entitled, "Traffic," of the Glendale Heights Village Code is further amended as follows:

By amending each and every reference made to "Village Administrator" from "Village Administrator" to "Chief of Police."

Section 3: That Section 11-10-4 entitled, "Penalty," of Chapter 10 entitled, "Parades, Processions and Marches," of Title 11 entitled, "Traffic," of the Glendale Heights Village Code is amended to read as follows:

"11-10-4: PENALTY:

Any person, group of persons, or organizations convicted of violating any of the provisions of this Chapter shall be fined an amount not less than seventy five dollars (\$75.00) or more than seven hundred fifty dollars (\$750.00) for each offense."

Section 4: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
