

TOBACCO SOLD TO MINOR

[Glendale Heights, Illinois] One business was cited by the Glendale Heights Police Department for the sale of tobacco to a minor under 18 years of age during a village-wide compliance check of tobacco sellers on Tuesday, February 19, 2008.

In an effort to monitor compliance with state and local laws, Glendale Heights Police Investigators periodically conduct unannounced inspections of establishments that sell tobacco products. In a recent inspection of 32 businesses, the following establishment was cited for selling tobacco products to a person under the age of 18:

It is the policy of the Glendale Heights Police Department to conduct periodic inspections of all village establishments that sell tobacco products. Any violations discovered could result in a fine of \$10.00- \$750.00 to the seller or owner.
