## DUI Enforcement Campaign Nets 13 Arrests

The Glendale Heights Police Department arrested 13 drivers for driving under the influence of alcohol and/or drugs, and issued an additional 438 traffic citations during the third of eight Mini-Grant Alcohol Enforcement Grant (MAP) campaigns. The campaign ran from January 30, 2009 through February 15, 2009 where additional officers worked the streets monitoring traffic, with primary emphasis on impaired drivers. This was made possible from a traffic grant from the Illinois Department of Transportation. Of the 438 citations written, 96 were for speeding, 33 persons were arrested for driving with suspended/revoked driver licenses, and 309 citations were issued for other moving violations.

The Glendale Heights Police Department remains committed to removing intoxicated motorists from the roadways. Chief Michael Marron and the officers of the Glendale Heights Police Department would like to remind the public that drinking and driving don't mix, and that seat belts save lives. Please slow down, buckle up, and drive safely.
