DUI Enforcement Campaign Nets 10 Arrests

The Glendale Heights Police Department arrested 10 drivers for driving under the influence of alcohol and/or drugs, and issued an additional 415 traffic citations during the fourth of eight Mini-Grant Alcohol Enforcement Grant (MAP) campaigns. The campaign ran from March 6, 2009 through March 22, 2009 where additional officers worked the streets monitoring traffic, with primary emphasis on impaired drivers. This was made possible from a traffic grant from the Illinois Department of Transportation. Of the 415 citations written, 135 were for speeding, 30 persons were arrested for driving with suspended/revoked driver licenses, 6 for other alcohol related/ and or drug related violations, 13 for seat belt violations, and 234 citations were issued for other moving violations.

The Glendale Heights Police Department remains committed to removing intoxicated motorists from the roadways. Chief Michael Marron and the officers of the Glendale Heights Police Department would like to remind the public that drinking and driving don't mix, and that seat belts save lives. Please slow down, buckle up, and drive safely.
