

ALCOHOL SOLD TO MINOR

[Glendale Heights, Illinois] Two businesses in Glendale Heights were cited by the Glendale Heights Police Department for the sale of alcohol beverage to a minor less than 21 years of age on Thursday, May 24, 2007.

In an effort to monitor compliance with state and local laws, Glendale Heights Police Investigators periodically conduct unannounced inspections of establishments that sell alcoholic beverages. In a recent inspection of 37 businesses, two establishments were cited after selling alcoholic beverages to persons under the age of 21:

- 7-11
1408 Bloomingdale Rd.
Employee: Ana Mamani, 32, of Glendale Heights
- Ramada Inn
780 E. North Avenue
Employee: Dana Wilson, 46, of West Chicago

It is the policy of the Glendale Heights Police Department to conduct periodic inspections of all Village Establishments that sell alcoholic beverages. Any violations discovered could result in a fine of \$10.00- \$750.00 to the seller or owner, and a potential suspension of the establishment's license to sell alcoholic beverages.

Members of the public are to be reminded that these complaints contain only charges and are not proof of the defendants' guilt. A defendant is presumed innocent and is entitled to a fair trial in which it is the government's burden to prove his or her guilt beyond a reasonable doubt.
