Glendale Heights- On Monday, August 13, 2007 officers from the Glendale Heights Police Department responded to a traffic accident at the intersection of Bloomingdale Road and Fullerton Avenue. Officers located a three vehicle accident involving a pick up truck, a van, and a sports utility vehicle with the van rolled onto its side. Glenside and Bloomingdale Fire Departments also responded to the scene and were able to extricate an occupant of the van who was ultimately airlifted to Loyola Medical Center by Lifestar helicopter. Two other occupants of involved vehicles were transported to Glen Oaks Medical Center and a fourth person was transported to Central DuPage Hospital. The extent of the injuries is unknown at this time. Three additional people were treated and released at the scene. The identities of those involved are being withheld at this time pending the notification of relatives.

The cause of the accident is still under investigation by the Glendale Heights Police Department.
