## **Disorderly Conduct – Bomb Threat**

Glendale Heights – On Wednesday, September 17, 2008 at 6:48 PM the Glendale Heights Police Department along with the Bloomingdale Fire Department responded to Universal Technical Institute (UTI), 601 Regency, Glendale Heights for a report of a bomb threat. When officers arrived on the scene they assisted the schools administration with the evacuation of the UTI campus.

Several witnesses told police a student walked into a classroom and repeatedly stated “You better watch out there was a bomb that was going to go off at 7:00 p.m.” The campus was evacuated and a search of the school revealed no evidence of a bomb or any other incendiary devices.

During the investigation, school administrators were able to provide the police with the name of the student. The student, Derrick Williams, 21 years old, of South Holland was located by the South Holland police Department and taken into custody without incident. Williams was subsequently charged with one felony count of Disorderly Conduct.

Members of the public are reminded that this complaint contains only a charge and is not proof of the defendant's guilt. A defendant is presumed innocent and is entitled to a fair trial in which it is the government's burden to prove his or her guilt beyond a reasonable doubt.
