DUI Enforcement Campaign Nets 14 Arrests

The Glendale Heights Police Department arrested 14 drivers for driving under the influence of alcohol and/or drugs, and issued an additional 330 traffic citations during the first of eight Mini-Grant Alcohol Enforcement Grant (MAP) campaigns. The campaign ran from October 21, 2007 through November 3, 2007 where additional officers worked the streets monitoring traffic, with primary emphasis on impaired drivers. This was made possible from a traffic grant from the Illinois Department of Transportation. Of the 330 citations written, 130 were for speeding, 18 were for safety belt violations, 37 persons were arrested for driving with suspended/revoked driver licenses, and 4 persons were arrested for drug offenses.

The Glendale Heights Police Department remains committed to removing intoxicated motorists from the roadways. Chief Marron and the officers of the Glendale Heights Police Department would like to remind the public that drinking and driving don't mix, and that seat belts save lives. Please slow down, buckle up, and drive safely.
