

Glendale Heights Man Arrested for Distributing Child Pornography

[Glendale Heights, Illinois] On Wednesday, December 5th Glendale Heights Police assisted by investigators from the Illinois Attorney General's Computer Crimes Unit, arrested Evan W. Duty, 26, of the 100 block of E. Altgeld and charged him with one (1) count of Disseminating Child Pornography.

Glendale Heights Police were led to Duty through a child pornography investigation initiated by investigators from the Illinois Attorney General's Computer Crimes Unit in October. During that investigation, Duty was suspected of sharing child pornography files over the Internet with other users. Evidence developed in the investigation was subsequently turned over to investigators from the Glendale Heights Police Department who obtained authorization for a search warrant for Duty's residence. The search warrant was executed early Wednesday morning and investigators seized Duty's personal computer, which was found to contain numerous files depicting child pornography.

Duty, who was present at the time the search warrant was executed, was subsequently arrested and later turned over to the DuPage County Jail where he is presently being held on \$75,000 bond.

Members of the public are reminded that this complaint contains only a charge and is not proof of the defendant's guilt. A defendant is presumed innocent and is entitled to a fair trial in which it is the government's burden to prove his or her guilt beyond a reasonable doubt.
