## **Glendale Heights Bank Robbery**

GLENDALE HEIGHTS, IL – On Friday, December 09, 2011 at about 5:27 p.m. officers from the Glendale Heights Police Department responded to a report of a bank robbery at the TCF Bank, 567 E. North Avenue, Glendale Heights. (S/W Corner of North Avenue and Glen Ellyn Road).

Upon arrival of officers it was discovered that a male black subject, approximately in his twenties, wearing a black winter jacket, black hat and having dark rimmed glasses approached the teller at the TCF Bank demanding money. Upon being provided an undisclosed amount of United States Currency, the subject exited the door on the north east corner of the bank leaving the scene on foot in an unknown direction of travel.



### **Wanted**

**Male black subject, approx. 20 years of age, 5'7", medium build, black stocking cap, dark rimmed glasses, dark brown jacket, weapon implied.**
