Residential Burglaries

The Glendale Heights Police Department would like to make you aware of a string of daytime Residential Burglaries that have been reported to our Agency over the past month. During the month of November and December we have had four (4) Residential Burglaries committed in the North portion of the village. The following dates and locations have been reported at this time:

- Thursday November 10, 2011 in the 1900 block of Glenrock
- Saturday November 12, 2011 in the 1900 block of President
- Friday November 25, 2011 in the 0-100 block of Mill Pond
- Thursday December 8, 2011 in the 0-100 block of East Stevenson

It is believed that all of these burglaries occurred during daytime or early evening hours while the residents were away. Entry on each of the incidents was gained by force through the front or back doors and a number of smaller items were taken.

Residents are asked to take precautions to help reduce their chances of being a victim of residential burglaries. Some suggestions are listed below:

- Lock all door and windows.
- Keep your house well lit at night and leave a light on inside of the house.
- Keep views of exterior doorways unobstructed.
- Install a house alarm and turn it on every time you leave the house, even for a short period of time.
- If leaving on vacation or a long period of time, let your neighbors know and contact the Police Department to have them do "Extra Patrols" by your house.

At this time no suspects have been identified and we are requesting the public's assistance. We ask that the community report any suspicious activity in the neighborhood by calling 911.
