

Glendale Heights Man Arrested for Possession of Child Pornography

[Glendale Heights, Illinois] On Wednesday, December 17th Glendale Heights Police assisted by investigators from the Illinois Attorney General's Internet Crimes against Children (ICAC) Task Force, arrested Arturo Silva, 43, of the 100 block of E. Lincoln, Glendale Heights and charged him with one (1) count of Possession of Child Pornography.

Glendale Heights Police were led to Silva through a child pornography investigation initiated by the Attorney General's ICAC Task Force in November. Evidence developed in that investigation was subsequently turned over to investigators from the Glendale Heights Police Department who obtained authorization for a search warrant for Silva's residence. The search warrant was executed early Wednesday morning and investigators seized computer equipment from Silva's home, which was found to contain several computerized files depicting child pornography.

Silva, who was present at the time the search warrant was executed, was subsequently arrested and later turned over to the DuPage County Jail where he is presently being held on \$60,000 bond.

Members of the public are reminded that this complaint contains only a charge and is not proof of the defendant's guilt. A defendant is presumed innocent and is entitled to a fair trial in which it is the government's burden to prove his or her guilt beyond a reasonable doubt.
