- Vaccine clinics. Vaccine clinics continued at the Sports Hub and allowed ages 12 and over. Over 90% of seniors 65 and over in DuPage county have been vaccinated.
- Added additional walk a mile class. Tuesdays 8:30am and 9:30am. 30 people can now sign up and we eliminated lottery.
- Added additional forever Fit class. Monday and Wednesday 10am. 30 people can sign up.
- Lunches resumed with DSCC.
- Rentals with 50 people were allowed. Ten parties were booked in May. On May 14th rentals went up to 60% occupancy allowing us 75 people.
