Village Operations

- **Per the Governor's Executive Order, all Village Facilities are closed to the public until further notice**
- There will be NO disruptions to emergency (police, fire, EMS) and Public Works operations
- Please pay your water bill online at www.glendaleheights.org (credit card) or via the drop off box (check; no cash will be accepted) located on the south side of Village Hall. From March 23, 2020 through April 7, 2020, the Village will not be shutting off water for non-payment of water bills. Additionally, late fees on the March water bill due April 6th and April 2020 water bills due May 4th will be waived.
- The following citations will be suspended: Village Vehicle License (stickers) tickets; overnight parking on streets from 2:00 am to 6:00 am without Village Sticker; dog and cat licenses
- Local food and beverage sales tax for the months of March, April and May will be deferred without penalty per the Governor's Executive Order
- Late fees on parking tickets issued in March and April will be waived

- The Parks and Recreation Committee, Character Counts Coalition, Neighborhood Watch, the Property Enhancement Committee, and Senior Citizens Advisory Committee are cancelled
