The meeting was called to order at 8:34am.

The minutes of the March 23, 2022 meeting were reviewed and accepted.

#### **Bake Sale**

The group reviewed the bake sale. The total purchases were \$500.00 with very generous and creative donations this year. The group was very positive about the sale and noted that most all the donated items were sold long before the close of the sale. Only a few were sold at half price. Items were priced from 25 cents to \$5.00 with all the cakes and more expensive items going very early.

Jennifer asked the Committee to decide how to use the bake sale proceeds and suggested that a fund be set up to act as a way to donate to any members who may need assistance to pay for activities or events. The group decided to use a portion of the \$500 as a donation fund. Lavonna suggested that a dart board would be a nice addition to the game room along with the card tables and pool table. Pat offered to research types and prices of dart boards.

The Committee voted unanimously (4-0) to use a portion of the bake sale proceeds for a donation fund to help members who need financial help and part of it for a dart board for the game room.

The architects did come to plans and estimates to include an addition on the back of the building for storage, new carpets and new sound system. Additional funds will be needed above the grant amount. Keith will coordinate with architects on the renovations.
