Attention Camp Participants!

I would like to thank you for joining us for the Junior Police Academy. This year the summer camp begins Monday, June 21, 2021 and runs through Friday, June 25, 2021. We will be doing some fun and exciting things during the week. There are some important things you need to know about the summer camp.

- Every day you need to bring a sack lunch with your name written on it. (A water bottle and lemonade will be provided for you.) On Friday, you will NOT need to bring a lunch. A pizza lunch will be served.
- If planning on and you have registered to use the Sports Hub Aquatic Center at the end of camp each day, you need to have a swimsuit and a towel. Camp ends around 2:00PM each day. Arrangements have been made to allow pool use on your own after that time. A schedule for the pool will be made available the first day of camp. In addition, Tuesday through Thursday we will be using squirt guns for target shooting practice, so expect to get wet. A towel will come in handy!
- Do not forget sunscreen!
- On Monday, we will be having our "physical agility test". **Gym shoes are required.**
- We start each day at 8:00AM and will meet on the front steps of the Civic Center. Drop off in the circle drive. Parents, please stay in your vehicle for COVID-19 safety considerations.
- Parent pick up will be in the circle drive. Those of you planning to swim, will be walked over to the Aquatic Center. Parents can pick up there at the end of the swim session. *Note: camp will have concluded and JPA staff will no longer be on site at the pool after 2:30PM.
- Attached are waivers, which **must** be completed and turned in on or before the first day of camp, Monday June 21, 2021.
- Please call before 8:00am each day if your child will be absent for the day. *

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Junior Police Academy COVID-19 Guidelines

To ensure the safety of all campers, The Glendale Heights Police Department will be implementing the current guidelines of the Illinois Department of Public Health as it relates to the COVID-19 pandemic. To assist with this, we are asking for parents to adhere to the following:

- Please make sure your child is free of fever, cough or otherwise feeling well prior to arriving at camp each day. If they feel sick, please keep them home from camp and call to let us know.*

-When dropping off each morning please stay in your vehicle. We will be there to greet your child and assist them getting settled each day. **Please do not arrive any sooner than 7:45am.** (If you have questions any morning of drop-off just let us know and then pull forward so other parents can drop off their children. We will walk over and talk to you.)

-Remind your child of the importance of social distancing and keeping their space between other camp participants. When that is not possible, to remember to wear face coverings.

Here is what we will be doing to ensure a safe and fun as always camp experience!

- Camp is limited to 24 participants
- Symptom screenings and temperature checks, or individual self-certification that campers are free of symptoms before entering the Civic Center each day
- Face coverings are required when inside a building or when 6ft social distancing cannot be adhered to
- Participants will be split into teams of 5 to 10 individuals doing different activities in different locations whenever possible
- Ensure rooms, tables, and any other equipment are cleaned and sanitized at the end of each day

WAIVER/RELEASE FOR COMMUNICABLE DISEASES INCLUDING COVID-19 ASSUMPTION OF RISK / WAIVER OF LIABILITY / INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT

In consideration of being allowed to participate on behalf of The Village of Glendale Heights Police Dept. Junior Police Academy and related events and activities, the undersigned acknowledges, appreciates, and agrees that:

1. Participation includes possible exposure to and illness from infectious diseases including but not limited to MRSA, influenza, and COVID-19. While particular rules and personal discipline may reduce this risk, the risk of serious illness and death does exist; and,

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2021 Junior Police Academy-Bicycle Patrol

Dear Parents of Junior Police Academy Camp Participants,

One of our camp activities is a unit on "Bicycle Patrol". We will conduct this on **Friday June 25th**. Your child can participate only if they have a bicycle and a **helmet** at camp that day. The kids can ride their bike to camp (with your permission) or you can transport their bike in your vehicle when you drop them off.

We can register each of the campers' bikes through the Glendale Heights Police Department (if they are riding their own). This is an important thing to do if your child's bike ever gets stolen. We will offer a brief lesson on bicycle safety and then will head out into the neighborhood on a bike ride.

There will be different groups of riders depending on ability and endurance with at least one instructor chaperoning each group. We will be riding on the neighborhood streets surrounding the village complex, riding through parks and will eventually end up on the paths at Camera Park.

Safety is our biggest concern and of course, we want everyone to be safe so....
The rule is...

No one rides unless they have a bike in working condition and a helmet!

If we have a majority of participants able to ride, we will proceed. We will have a second group doing a different activity if anyone is not able to ride. Please feel free to contact us at 630-909-5449 if you have any questions or concerns about this event.
