On Tuesday, January 17 at approximately 11:45 AM, the Glendale Heights Police Department was summoned to the 1100 block of Harbor Court for a report of two deceased subjects inside a residence. Responding Officers and Paramedics made entry into the townhome and located, Tina Stevanovic, 49, and her husband, Darko Radonjic, 48 inside the residence. Stevanovic displayed multiple apparent gunshot wounds and was pronounced deceased at the residence. Officers found Radonjic to be alive, but unconscious, and he was transported from the scene for medical treatment. Both subjects were residents of the townhome. There were no other people in the residence and no signs of forced entry to the residence.

An autopsy for Stevanovic has been scheduled for January 18 at the DuPage County Coroner's Office.

Radonjic has not regained consciousness and is currently in police custody pending further investigation while receiving medical care at an area hospital. The cause of Radonjic's current medical condition is unknown. He has not been criminally charged as of this writing.

The Glendale Heights Police Department is continuing to investigate the death in conjunction with The DuPage County Coroner's Office and the DuPage County Major Crimes Task Force. Investigators are confident that there is no risk to the safety of the community and no other people are being sought in connection with the woman's death.
