On Thursday, February 9, 2017, Glendale Heights Police Officers Chris Parsons and Nick Santoyo were dispatched to the 700 block of Terry Lane for the report of a Heroin overdose. Upon arrival at the residence, officers located a female who was unconscious and not breathing because of heroin ingestion. Officers began life saving procedures on the victim and Officer Chris Parsons administered two doses of Narcan (Naloxone), to the victim. After the second dose, the victim began to show signs of life and medical care was turned over to paramedics and firefighters of the Glenside Fire Protection District. The victim was taken to AMITA Health Adventist Medical Center, GlenOaks, for further treatment.
